MISSION STATEMENT

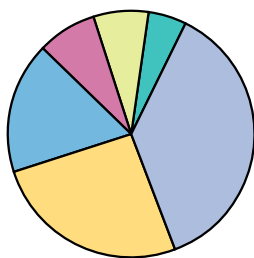
The mission of Flanner House is to support, advocate for and empower individuals, children and families by applying educational, social and economic resources that move the community towards self-sufficiency.

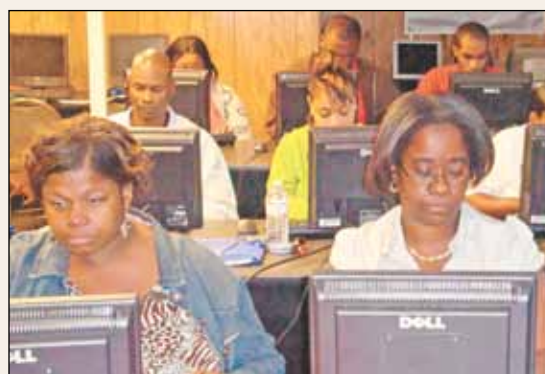

Additionally, the agency provides quality early childhood educational and youth enrichment summer programs. The agency operates a nationally accredited Child Development Center that is Indiana state licensed and

has earned level four (top level) Paths to Quality. The senior population is also a priority at Flanner House. The agency operates a senior day program which provides services such as socialization opportunities, health screenings and transportation that allows area seniors to remain in their own homes and age in place.
